

You will be linked with the guest network and be able to greet every guest by name. Don't forget to ask them how their Cosmic Churro was earlier!




Your shift will be one of the four 10 hour shifts. Extended lunch breaks are planned so that if your significant other has a conflicting schedule you can still spend time together.



The small orange dots are actually guests! The children on the left are magnified 15 times!

How does it work? Superconducting coils and magnets make up levitation, propulsion, and dynamic compensation systems, keeping the Zentrifuge perfectly level despite movement or weight variations



All of the main walkways are curved to prevent guests from seeing too far down the curve and being unnerved

Guests will be able to visualize information by paying attention to environments throughout the Zentrifuge. Let them know that the fireflies in Infinity Gardens each represent someone moving somewhere else on the ship!

The blue coils are superconductors that are used for propulsion

The sub-level is backstage with office spaces, emergency services, and any equipment storage you may need to access

If a guest is having trouble with the near continuous daylight, be sure to make them aware of the areas which are always lighted as night

The Zentrifuge is located within a 1-hour monorail ride from Spaceport Luna, co-located on the rim of the Shackleton Crater. Food, energy, and water resources are shared between the two if needed.
